WINE NOTES

Under the right conditions, Marsanne has the potential to produce a truly unique wine with an exotic personality. Traditionally it's a finicky grape that often struggles to ripen, and is hard to find outside its native Rhône Valley. Fortunately, the Alder Springs Vineyard offers a delicious California version of its Rhône counterparts. Located just a few miles from the Pacific Ocean at an elevation of 2,700 feet, it's a hidden gem with the perfect microclimate for producing rich, aromatic Marsanne that reminds us of our French favorites.
