WINE NOTES

Some of our favorite Sauvignon Blanc comes from France's Loire Valley. At its best it is not only crisp and refreshing, but also exhibits a rich mouthfeel that distinguishes it from Sauvignon Blanc produced elsewhere. Though we modeled ours in the same Old World style, we're always looking for ways to showcase our Sonoma roots. With that in mind, we source this Sauvignon Blanc from the famed Moon Mountain District, not far from our winery. Its bright, crisp notes are augmented by a rich mouthfeel imparted by several months in neutral French oak. This approach to Sauvignon Blanc has earned many converts among those who once doubted the wine's potential for complexity.
